

FAQ's

1. What if it rains the day of the ceremony?

- An **Inclement Weather Plan** will be placed under the Graduation Information link on the Daniel High School website.
- A decision to move the ceremony inside due to inclement weather will be made no later than Thursday, May 24th. This decision will be communicated via a phone dialer, a webpage and Schoology announcement, Facebook and Twitter.

2. What time will the stadium open for guests?

- The stadium gates will open at 7:30AM for guests.
- Restroom facilities will be available.

3. Can I go inside the school to visit with my graduate before the ceremony?

- No. Only current DWD faculty and staff will be allowed access to graduates before the ceremony.
- *In the event of inclement weather, guests will still not have access to graduates before the ceremony.*

4. Is there a reserved lot for handicapped parking?

- Yes. Handicapped parking will be available for guests in need. Guests are reminded that a handicapped sticker or hang tag must be **clearly seen on or in the vehicle** in order to be allowed to park in the reserved lot. (*See Parking Map for location of reserved handicapped parking.*) Police officers will only allow a vehicle to enter the stadium gate if the handicapped sticker or hang tag is on or in the vehicle.

5. Will someone help us get from the handicapped lot to the stadium?

- Yes. Transportation from the reserved parking lot to the stadium entrance will be provided for guests who need mobility assistance.

6. Will the concession stands be open?

- Yes. Guests may purchase refreshments during the ceremony.

7. Can I go onto the track to take pictures?

- Not before or during the ceremony. Guests will be allowed onto the track and field after the ceremony to take pictures with the graduates.

8. Is there an alternate viewing location if I or a family member has difficulty with the heat?

- Yes. **If the weather remains clear and the ceremony is held outdoors as planned**, indoor seating will be made available for guests who would feel more comfortable inside. A live-stream of the ceremony will be shown in the auditorium and seating is available for up to 600 guests. If there are concerns over heat, we encourage guests to plan to use this indoor viewing option.
- Guests may also view the ceremony from home via remote access. Instructions for how to view the ceremony from home will be posted to the Graduation Information link on the school webpage.

9. What if I or a family member begins to feel unwell due to heat during the ceremony?

- EMS will be on site before, during and after the ceremony for any medical emergencies. Police officers and district staff will be stationed throughout the stands, so please notify them immediately if EMS assistance is needed.

10. Can I purchase a video of the ceremony?

- We will not have a videographer selling copies of the video this year. Guests may videotape the ceremony from the stands, but are asked to please be mindful of other families when doing so. Please refrain from blocking views of other guests.
