

# FAQ's

## 1. What if it rains the day of the ceremony?

- Please refer to the **Inclement Weather Plan** under the Graduation Information link on the Daniel High School website.
- A decision to move the ceremony inside due to inclement weather will be made no later than Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup>. This decision will be communicated via a phone dialer, a webpage and Schoology announcement, Facebook and Twitter. Please refer to the Inclement Weather Plan for details about tickets and seating.

## 2. What time will the stadium open for guests?

- The stadium gates will open at 9:00AM for guests.
- Restroom facilities will be available.
- *In the event of inclement weather, the school will open at 9:00AM as well. See Inclement Weather Plan.*

## 3. Can I go inside the school to visit with my graduate before the ceremony?

- No. Only current DWD faculty and staff will be allowed access to graduates before the ceremony.
- *In the event of inclement weather, guests will still not have access to graduates before the ceremony. See Inclement Weather Plan.*

#### 4. Is there a reserved lot for handicapped parking?

- Yes. Handicapped parking will be available for guests in need. Guests are reminded that a handicapped sticker or hang tag must be **clearly seen on or in the vehicle** in order to be allowed to park in the reserved lot. *(See Parking Map for location of reserved handicapped parking.)* Police officers will only allow a vehicle to enter the stadium gate if the handicapped sticker or hang tag is on or in the vehicle.
- *In the event of inclement weather, the same reserved parking and transportation will be available. See Inclement Weather Plan.*

#### 5. Will someone help us get from the handicapped lot to the stadium?

- Yes. Transportation from the reserved parking lot to the stadium entrance will be provided for guests who need mobility assistance.
- *In the event of inclement weather, transportation from the lot and assistance into the building will still be provided. See Inclement Weather Plan.*

#### 6. Will the concession stands be open?

- Yes. Guests may purchase refreshments during the ceremony.

## 7. Can I go onto the track to take pictures?

- Not before or during the ceremony. Guests will be allowed onto the track and field after the ceremony to take pictures with the graduates.
- *In the event of inclement weather, pictures may be taken with graduates on campus BEFORE 9:00AM and after the ceremony. Graduates are to be in the auxiliary gym no later than 9:00AM for line-up. Guests will not have access to the students during line-up.*

## 8. Is there an alternate viewing location if I or a family member has difficulty with the heat?

- Yes. **If the weather remains clear and the ceremony is held outdoors as planned**, indoor seating will be made available for guests who would feel more comfortable inside. A live-stream of the ceremony will be shown in the auditorium and seating is available for up to 600 guests. If there are concerns over heat, we encourage guests to plan to use this indoor viewing option.
- Guests may also view the ceremony from home via Planet High School. Please see instructions for how to view the live stream under the graduation information tab on the Daniel website.

9. What if I or a family member begins to feel unwell due to heat during the ceremony?

- EMS will be on site before, during and after the ceremony for any medical emergencies. Police officers and district staff will be stationed throughout the stands, so please notify them immediately if EMS assistance is needed.

10. Can I purchase a video of the ceremony?

- We will not have a videographer selling copies of the video this year. An archived copy of the ceremony will be available via Planet High School. Please refer to the Planet High School Instructions document under the Graduation Information link on the school's website.
- Guests may videotape the ceremony from the stands, but are asked to please be mindful of other families when doing so. Please refrain from blocking views of other guests.
